Greta Thunberg, climate change activist, [speaks out at the UN](#) reminding us, why switching to Electric Vehicles is so important. Upon realizing her generation won't have a future unless the world's politicians act now on climate change, then 15-year-old Greta Thunberg skipped school in August 2018 to protest outside the Swedish parliament. What started as a one person strike soon gained global momentum.
