EVmatch is a peer-to-peer network for EV charging - like Airbnb - enabling EV owners to list and rent out their home charging stations. City of Sacramento Releasing Draft of EV Strategy

Sacramento will release a draft EV Strategy on Friday, October 19th for public comment. SacBee: More power for EVs in Sacramento?

It may soon become a lot easier for Sacramento drivers to get plugged in. Legislation on Gov. Brown's desk would allow city officials and private property owners to install charging stations for EVs on curbsides of public streets. 2017 Cruise Fest Report

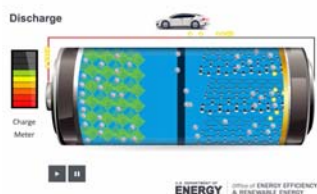
